PCI Meetings

Government of India cancelled PCI recognition and hence PCI split into two. WBFI EC members decided to attend both faction's meetings as we were not aware who the real PCI was. Tamil Nadu State Championship

In May 2015, we partnered with Join Hands Social Welfare Trust, Arakkonam and organised "Tamil Nadu State League Championship" at Arakkonam from May 22 to 24, 2015. Six teams, 70 wheelchair basketball players from Tamil Nadu participated in this match and prior to that all players were given 3 days coaching at Thiruvannamalai with support from the Leprosy Missionaries Trust of India, Thiruvannamlai.

WBFI is recognised by International Wheelchair Basketball Federation, IWBF and placed in Asia Oceanic Zone in June 2015.

Clinics for Classifiers, Coaches, Referees and Players in Chennai

From September 4th to 13th, 2015, we organised first of its kind technical course for Classifiers, Coach and Referee in wheelchair basketball by bringing in Mr. Jess Markt from USA with support from the ICRC, New Delhi, Vels University and YWTC Charitable Trust.



Each course was organised for two days with theory and practical sessions. 18 Classifiers, 16 Coaches and 18 Referees participated from Jammu and Kashmir, Uttar Pradesh, New Delhi, Maharashtra, Goa, Tamil Nadu, Kerala, Gujarat, Chatisgarh and Andhra Pradesh and from neighbouring country, Nepal.

We feel proud that Mr. I. Srinivas, IAS, Director General, SAI honoured us by his esteemed

presence to our Chennai clinic and interacted with the participants. These clinics were followed by 4 days workshop for experienced and new players. 20 experienced players and 45 new players got training from Jess. The event was inaugurated by Mr. Mohd. Nasimuddin, IAS, Principal Secretary, Dept for Welfare of Differently Abled Persons, Government of Tamil Nadu in the august presence of Mr Bharat Joshi, British Dy High Commissioner, Chennai, Dr Ishari Ganesh, Chencellor, Vels University and Mr Robertangelo Ciccone, Physical Rehabilitation Manager, the ICRC. With this workshop, we hope to reach out to more states with the support of participants.

First time, players, coach, classifier and referee from Jammu and Kashmir attended the clinics. ICRC donated 11 sports WCs to J&K team.

PCI, Nepal sent in their representative for coach, referee and classifier course.

Kerala team purchased 5 new WC's from Motivation UK.

2nd National Championship

The 2nd National Wheelchair Basketball Championship was organized by the Wheelchair Basketball Federation of India (WBFI) in partnership with the Sports Authority of India (SAI), Government of India and the International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC) from 2nd December to 6th December 2015 at Indira Gandhi Stadium Complex, ITO, New Delhi. As we are striving to promote wheelchair basketball sport for the benefit of persons with disabilities, we feel happy for planning this on the occasion of International Day of Persons with Disabilities (3rd Dec.).

Mr. Injeti Srinivasan, IAS, DG, SAI released our first souvenir.



The 1st National Championship that was held in Chennai last year was won by Maharashtra team. This year, 9 State teams competed for the trophy in this Championship. They are: Tamil Nadu, Karnataka, Kerala, Maharashtra, Delhi, Punjab, Haryana, Jammu & Kashmir, and Uttar Pradesh. A special Women's Championship (3 on 3 matches) was also held during this period and 4 women teams (mixed teams from various states — Sky Birds, Wood Peckers, Golden Bees and Dragon Warriors) competed for the Women's Championship. Sky Birds team won the Women's Championship.

A high powered delegation from the International Wheelchair Basketball Federation (IWBF) led by its President, Mr. Ulf Mehrens (Germany), IWBF Secretary General Ms. Maureen Orchard (Canada), IWBF Asia Oceania Zone (AOZ), President Mr. Saad Alazmaa (Kuwait), Mr Toufic Allouche, IWBF Classification Instructor, AOZ, and IWBF AOZ – Vice President for West Asia Region Ms Anisa Ibrahim Abbas Al Hooti attended this Championship and also offered technical support.

Closing ceremony for this course (4th Dec.'15 at 4pm) was graced by Ms Stuti Cacker, IAS, Chair Person for National Commission for the protection of Child Rights and Mr C K Khetan IAS, CEO, National Trust. Both the officials presented the certificates to the participants of this course.
